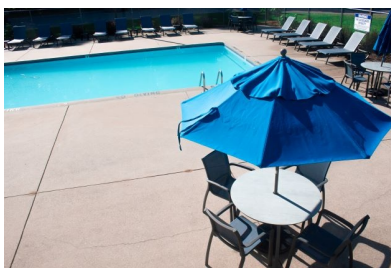
Harbor Springs

More upcoming improvements, events and activities to come!

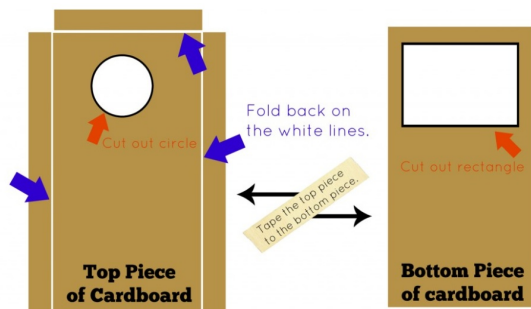

Summer time is a great time to be outdoors and enjoy time with Family and Friends. Here are some fun outdoor games for the family! They can be a fun DIY (Do It Yourself) project with the kids.



DIY : CORNHOLE

1. One or two cardboard boxes
2. A circular template (paper plate, bowl)
Something to trace the circle (marker, pencil, pen)
3. A box cutter (or knife)
4. Tape
5. Bean bags, affiliate link (or tossing alternatives like socks)
6. Art supplies (paint, glitter, markers, crayons, stickers, etc.)

DIY: MILK JUG WATERBALLON TOSS

1. Rinse out the milk jug and remove any labels. Turn the jug upside down and hold it by the handle.
2. Use a permanent marker to draw the cup opening on the bottom of the jug.
3. Cut out the opening with scissors. If your milk jug is made of stiff plastic, you might want to guard the edges with tape, but our jug was pliable and didn't need any extra guarding.
4. Decorate the outside of the jug with permanent markers.
